# USOAP Activities 1999-2024

From 1999 to 2024, a total number of **1041** USOAP activities have been performed as detailed below.

OPS: Aircraft operations

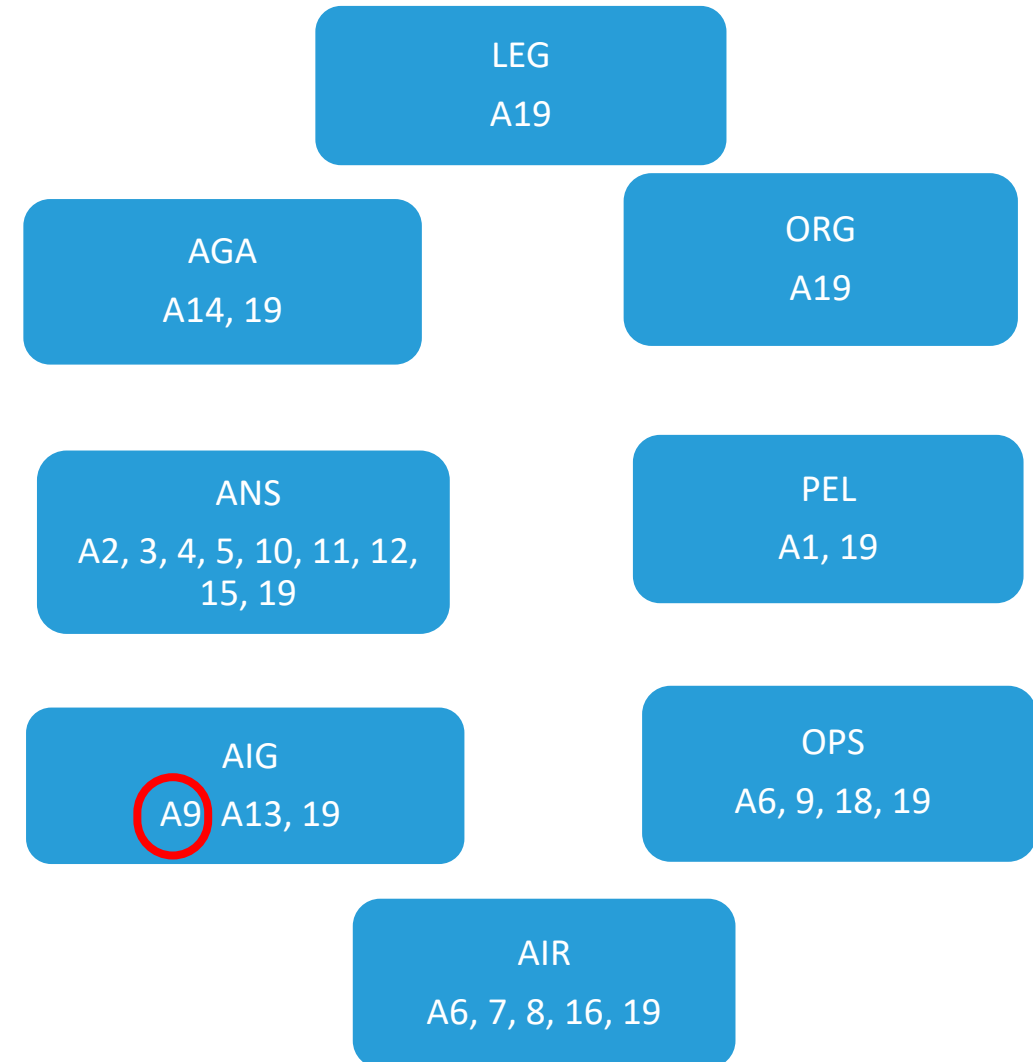
AIR: Airworthiness of aircraft

AGA: Aerodromes and ground aids

*790 Protocol Questions across all audit areas are the primary tool used for assessing the level of effective implementation of a State's safety oversight system based on the critical elements. PQs are supported by the Convention on International Aviation, ICAO Standards and other provisions.*



# Audit questions related to assistance to aircraft accident victims and their families

- 6.381 Has the investigation authority established and implemented procedures to ensure that relevant and timely information on the progress of the investigation will be provided to the families and accident survivors? (question applicable since 2008)

183 States have been audited

**60% of States had this question as “not satisfactory”**

- 6.383 Has the State established a comprehensive system for providing assistance to aircraft accident victims and their families? (question applicable since 2017)

42 States have been audited

**95% of States had this this question as “not satisfactory”**
