REGISTRATION AND SUBMISSION OF CREDENTIALS FOR THE 37TH SESSION OF THE ICAO ASSEMBLY (Montréal, 28 September to 8 October 2010)

Reference is made to State letters SA 37/1-09/89 and -10/20 dated 8 December 2009 and 29 March 2010, respectively, regarding participation in the 37th Session of the ICAO Assembly (Montréal, 28 September to 8 October 2010) and administrative arrangements.

In light of new security arrangements, it is necessary for participants to submit their original credentials, duly signed on behalf of the State or international organization concerned, either in advance of their registration for the Assembly or at the time of registration in order to receive an identification badge which will be required to access the Conference Centre and obtain any documentation, and, in the case of eligible States, to vote in the Council elections. If the original credentials are not received by the time of registration, only a temporary identification badge will be issued and the Delegate concerned will not be able to vote in the Council elections until such time as proper credentials are submitted. Participants are required to present a proof of identity when depositing their credentials.

Credentials may be deposited at the Credentials/Registration Centre at the international arrivals terminal at the Montréal-Pierre Elliott Trudeau International Airport on Saturday and Sunday, 25 and 26 September 2010 from 1200 to 2200 hours or at the Credentials/Registration Centre at the ICAO Conference Centre located at the Headquarters premises on Monday, 27 September 2010 from 0730 to 1700 hours and daily thereafter from 0800 to 1700 hours.

Participants are encouraged to submit their original credentials to the Secretary General prior to the opening of the session, and to send advance copies to the Secretary General by e-mail (ACSINBOX@icao.int) or by fax (+1 514 954-8077) as soon as possible.
