**FINAL REPORT OF THE CREDENTIALS COMMITTEE**

(Presented by the Chairman of the Credentials Committee)

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The Final Report of the Credentials Committee indicates that, out of 176 Member States and 39 observer delegations registered, credentials submitted by 171 Member States and 32 observer delegations were found in due and proper form.

1. At the First Meeting of its Plenary held on 28 September 2010, the Assembly agreed to the establishment of the Credentials Committee and the Delegations of Cambodia, Kuwait, Panama, Slovakia and Uganda were invited to nominate members for this Committee.

2. On 28 September 2010, the First Meeting of the Credentials Committee was held; the Committee was composed as follows:

Capt. Mak Sam Ol	(Cambodia)
Eng. Nader M. Al-Buloushi	(Kuwait)
Mr. Abdel E. Martínez E.	(Panama)
Mr. Pavol Helienek	(Slovakia)
Mr. John Wycliffe Kabbs Twijuke	(Uganda)

The Committee unanimously elected Mr. Abdel E. Martínez E., member of the delegation of Panama, Chairman of the Committee.

3. At the Second Meeting of the Plenary, the Chairman of the Credentials Committee presented an interim report to the Assembly and informed that, as of 1500 hours on 28 September 2010, 152 Member States and 32 observer delegations had registered for the Assembly. Credentials in due and proper form had been submitted by 148 Member States and 29 observer delegations.

4. The Assembly agreed on the recommendation of the Credentials Committee to urge all States and organizations that had not yet presented due and proper credentials to do so as soon as possible and to permit them to participate in its deliberations, with the delegations from the Members States having the right to vote.

5. At its Fourth Meeting on 5 October 2010, the Credentials Committee found that the credentials submitted by 171 Member States and from 32 observer delegations had been presented in due and proper form.
