**Objective: capture a complete picture of the airline industry!**

- ↗ Centralized at Business Intelligence Services (BIS)
- ↗ Regular operations:
  - ↗ 5 statistical data collections
  - ↗ 2 industry surveys
  - ↗ customized analysis
- ↗ A centralized Datamart hosts airline data
- ↗ Chief Economist leads IATA Economics team
- ↗ All airlines are invited to participate (IATA Members and non Members)
- ↗ All commercial services, international and domestic segments
