WHAT IS SECURITY CULTURE?

- A set of values, shared by everyone in an organisation, that determine how people are expected to think about and approach security.
 - Appreciation of the Threat
 - Compliance
 - Professionalism
 - Rejection of Tick/Check Box Security
 - Thinking Outside the Box

THINKING OUTSIDE THE BOX: SIX OF THE BEST

- Next time it will be different: strive for proactive measures rather than simply adopting reactive measures
- Reliance on technology: educate the workforce to appreciate their limitations and devise drills that exploit the limitations
- Motivating staff: empower screeners and trust and encourage people to act on their concerns
- Assessment of checkpoints: ensure that the primary consideration is the probability of detection (rather than throughput rates, footprint, and cost)

THINKING OUTSIDE THE BOX: SIX OF THE BEST

 Counter-terrorism or addressing all acts of unlawful interference?: focus on those with mental health issues, criminal intent and who may be unwitting victims

 Adoption of behavioural analysis: essential for a security culture and the solution to all the other challenges cited.
