#### Roles and Responsibilities of TSA T&E

The T&E Division provides both formal testing and support services throughout the technology procurement lifecycle to TSA Programs, TSA field elements, and other TSA/DHS stakeholders.

#### **T&E Operations and Infrastructure Branch**

- Comprised of 3 teams to support Agency's T&E of Transportation Security Equipment (TSE) at TSIF and in the field:
  - TSA Systems Integration Facility (TSIF) Operations
  - Test Article Management (TA)
  - Configuration Management (CM)
- Creates test articles, certifies testing processes, executes facility modifications, manages equipment logistics, and supports testing activities

#### **Evaluation & Quality Assurance Branch**

- Establishes effectiveness and suitability evaluation metrics for operational testing that supports acquisition decisions
- Provides comprehensive evaluations of systems' effectiveness and suitability, and documents findings in System Evaluation Reports (SER)
- Conducts "pop-up" equipment evaluations, including experiments/evaluations to support realworld emerging threats

#### TSIF Test Branch,

- Supports Qualification Testing (QT) activities in addition to planning, executing, and evaluating test events in support of Developmental Testing (DT), Test Article development, and ad-hoc test requests (pop-ups)
- Conducts demonstrations to stakeholders and tours to representatives of various organizations

#### Transportation Security Laboratory (TSL)

- Supports DT and QT with core capabilities in explosives and weapons detection
- Focuses on detection testing of bulk and trace explosives detection systems and equipment
- · Performs formal certification testing

#### **Operational Test Branch**

- Conducts planning and execution of Operational Testing (OT) events in a realistic, operational environment (airports) to independently validate the extent to which candidate systems are operationally effective and suitable for deployment
  - OT occurs once a system has successfully met DT/QT exit criteria and is conducted in support of an acquisition decision
  - OTB conducts additional field assessments that do not support an acquisition decision
