## REGULATOR'S ROLE

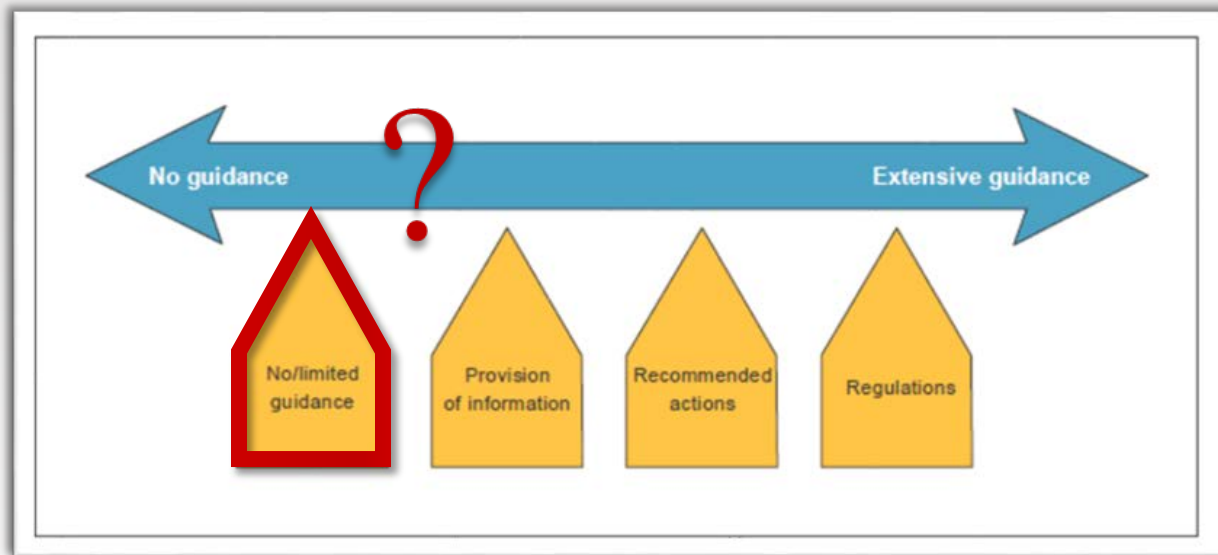
“Required to establish and implement procedures to share relevant information with operators, in a practical, timely manner, to assist them in conducting security risk assessment relating to their operations.”

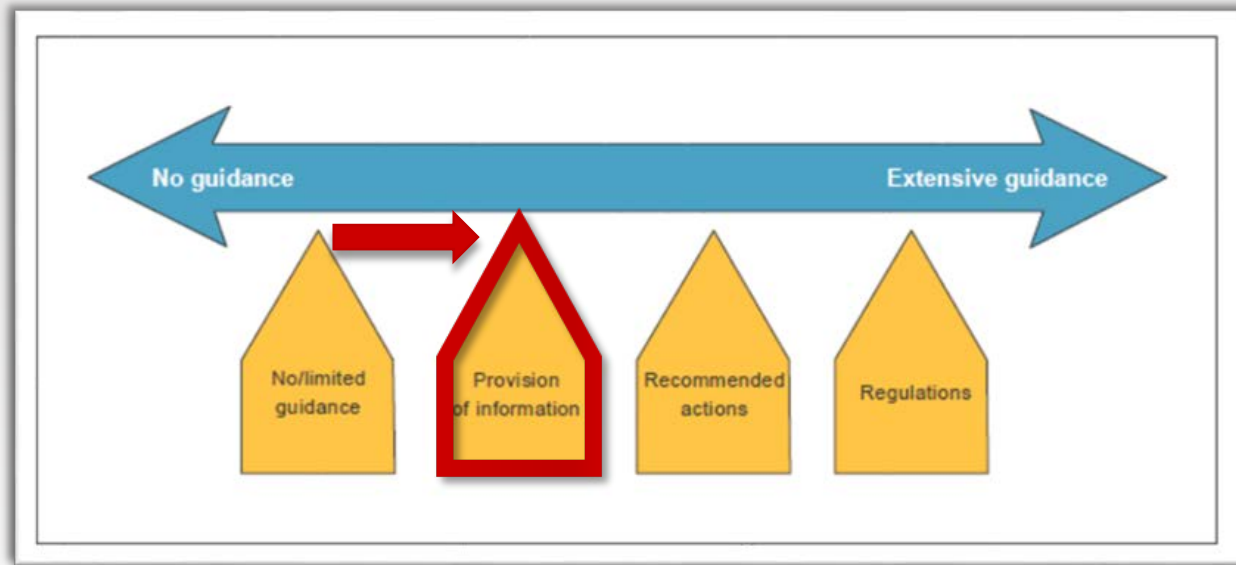

**Did we progress?** Yes.

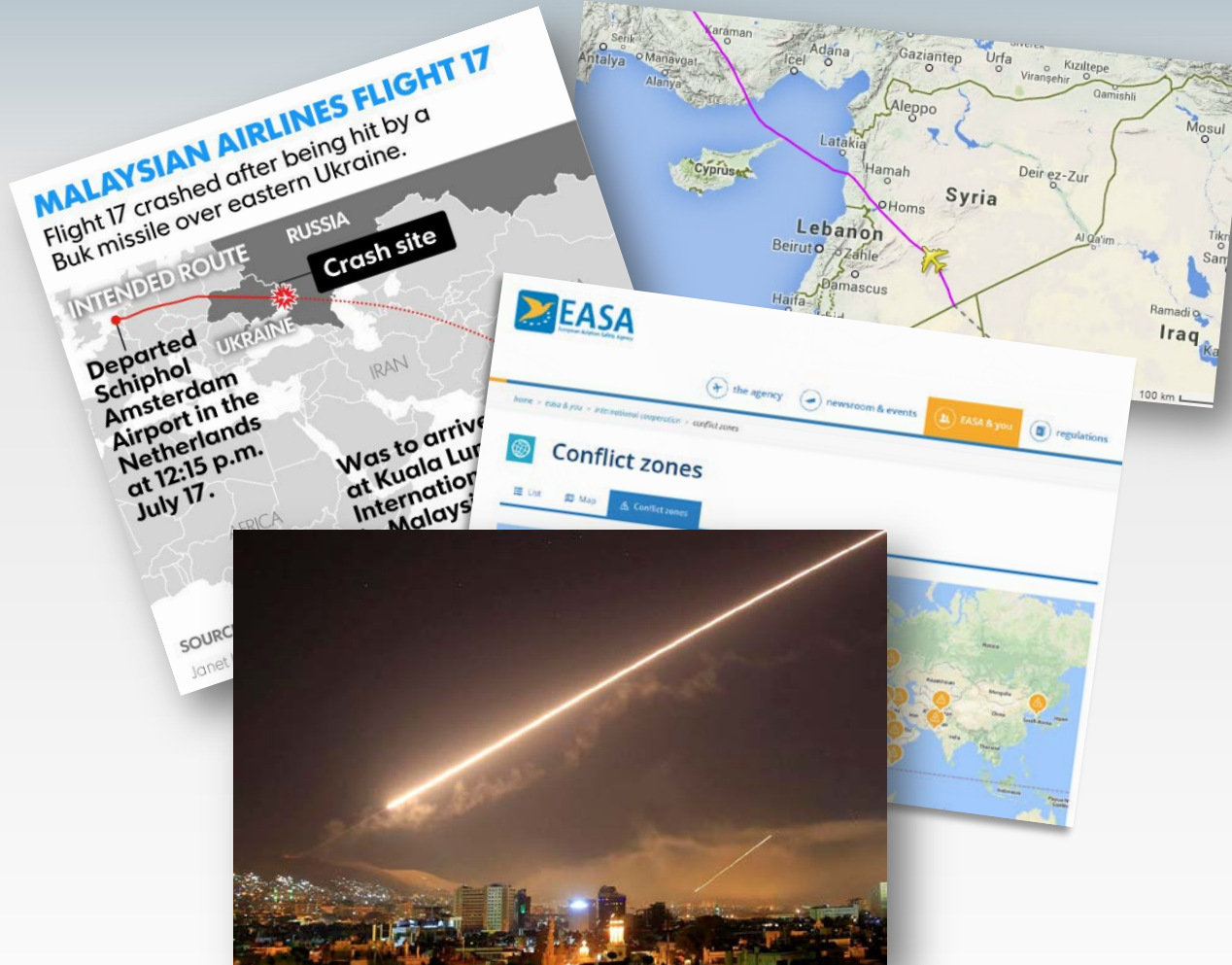
- Scheduled classified meetings.
