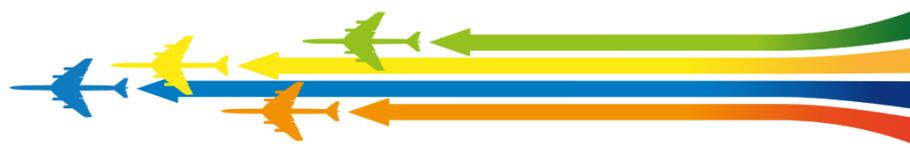

Our mission is to support the growth of Canada's advanced biofuels industry through coordinated research, innovation, effective education, smart policy and strategic partnerships.

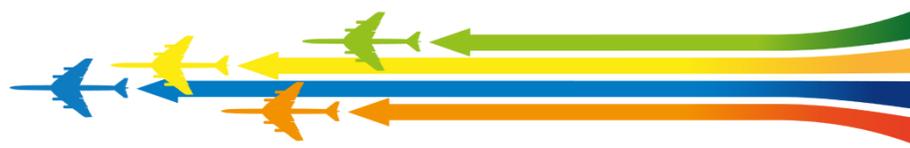






3. Promote a coordinated approach



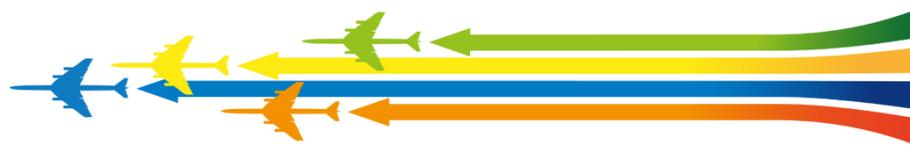
