#### AIM

Aims to **strengthen Member State capacity** to prevent, detect and intercept terrorists or serious criminals by **collecting and analyzing passenger data (API and PNR)**, in line with **UN Security Council Resolutions 2178, 2396 and 2482, ICAO Standards and Recommended Practices** and **international human rights principals**.

# UN Countering Terrorist Travel Programme

## Programme Key Figures



### OBJECTIVES & OUTCOMES

Provision of tailored support to strengthen Member State capacities to detect and prevent the travel of terrorists and serious criminals through the collection and analysis of travel information, including both **Advance Passenger Information (API)** and **Passenger Name Record (PNR)** data

- ✓ Enables the provision of **comprehensive support**: legislative, operational, transport industry engagement, technology adoption
- ✓ Well-established implementation methodology
- ✓ UNOCT-led to ensure **close coordination** and **cohesion** of support being provided




# IWG STRUCTURE



- **Eastern Europe** (Secretariat: OSCE; 18 Member States)
- **West Africa** (Secretariat: AIRCOP; 17 Member States)
- **Southern Africa** (Secretariat (TBC): SADC; 16 Member States )
- **Europe** (Secretariat: European Commission/EUROPOL)
- **Southeast Asia** (Secretariat (TBC); ASEAN Region / 9-10 Member States)
- **East Africa** (9 Member States)
- **Middle East / North Africa** (Secretariat (NAUSS))
- **Other/Future: Americas**

## IWG OBJECTIVES

- **To foster** cooperation on information sharing between PIUs based on reciprocity or mutual agreement
- **To build** and share a common language, best practices, and forum for peer-to-peer exchanges
- **To focus** on API/PNR and other data collected from passengers using different travel modalities, including air and maritime
- **To support** comprehensive border management




# UN Countering Terrorist Travel Programme

## Highlights of CT Travel Programme Work in the MENA Region

- ❖ **Regional Workshop in Cairo, Egypt:** Organized in cooperation with AIRCOP, held on May 29-31, 2023.
- ❖ **Privacy and Data Protection Workshop:** In collaboration with NTSC and NAUSS, held from October 20-22, 2024.
- ❖ **Regional Workshop on Enhancing the Connectivity between Airlines and PIU -27-29 Jan 2025.**
- ❖ **Upcoming Informal Working Group Launch:** Scheduled for this year in Riyadh, with invitations extended to all MENA countries.
- ❖ **Collaboration with Key Countries:** Currently working with Iraq, Jordan, Lebanon, Sudan, Algeria, and Morocco.
- ❖ **Expansion Plans:** Aiming to include all Arab countries in the program and provide ongoing support.
