- Harmonized regulations and policies among States in a region for better coordination and implementation of facilitation measures.
- Addressing challenges like political differences, resource constraints, and cultural issues that may impede implementation.

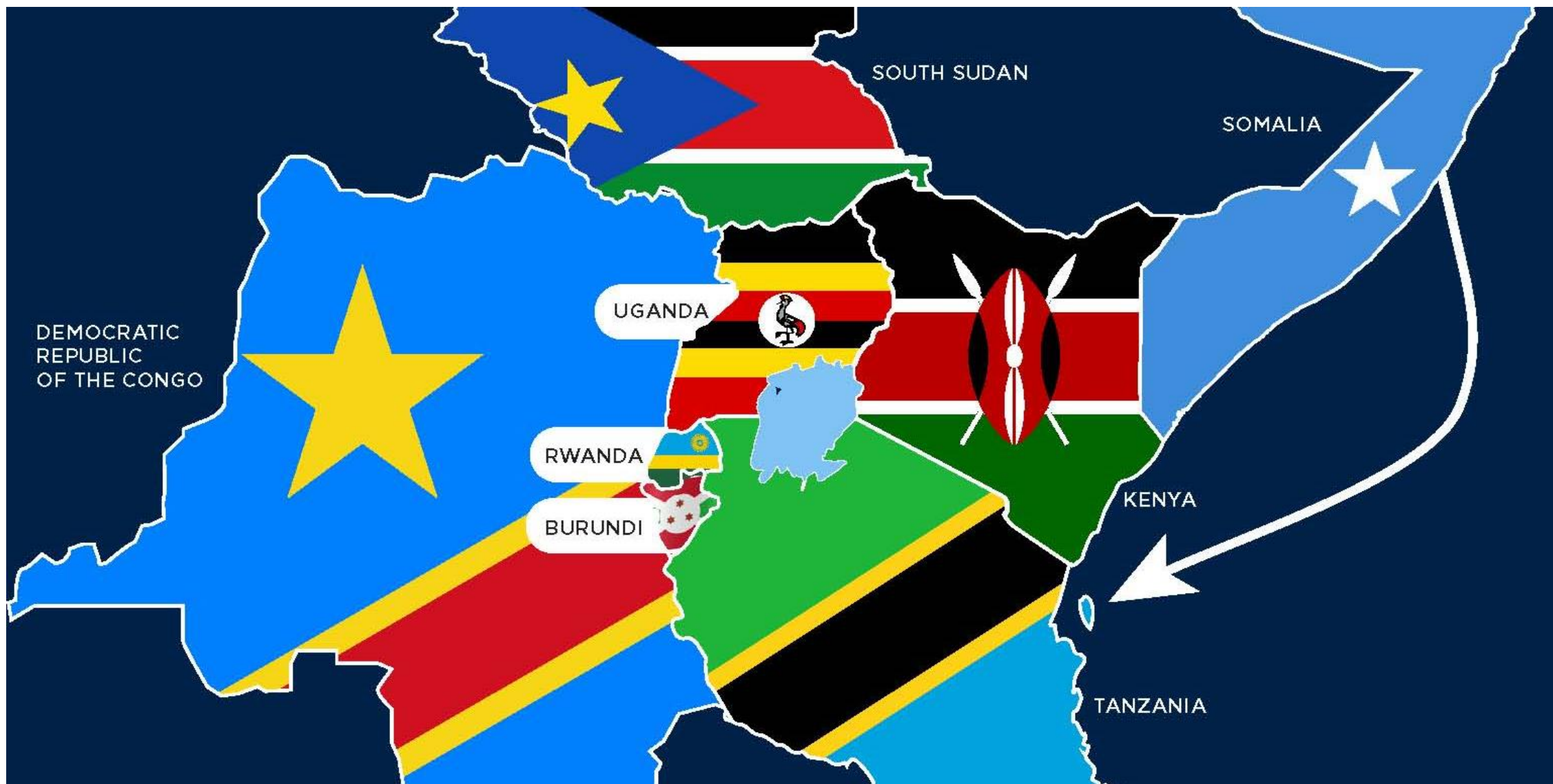
# Capacity Building and Implementation Support for States
