Facilitation programmes that enhance aviation accessibility and make aviation more inclusive reduce inequalities and support fairer access to opportunity




Aviation facilitation spurs international cooperation and partnerships needed for sustainable development

# **ICAO Long Term Passenger Growth**







All countries are expected to see traffic growing to/from their airports
