

Objectives: To support Member States in building their capabilities to detect and counter the movement of terrorists and serious criminals by collecting and using travel information and enhancing information exchange, in accordance with Security Council resolutions 2178 (2014), 2396 (2017), and 2482 (2019), international standards and relevant privacy laws.
