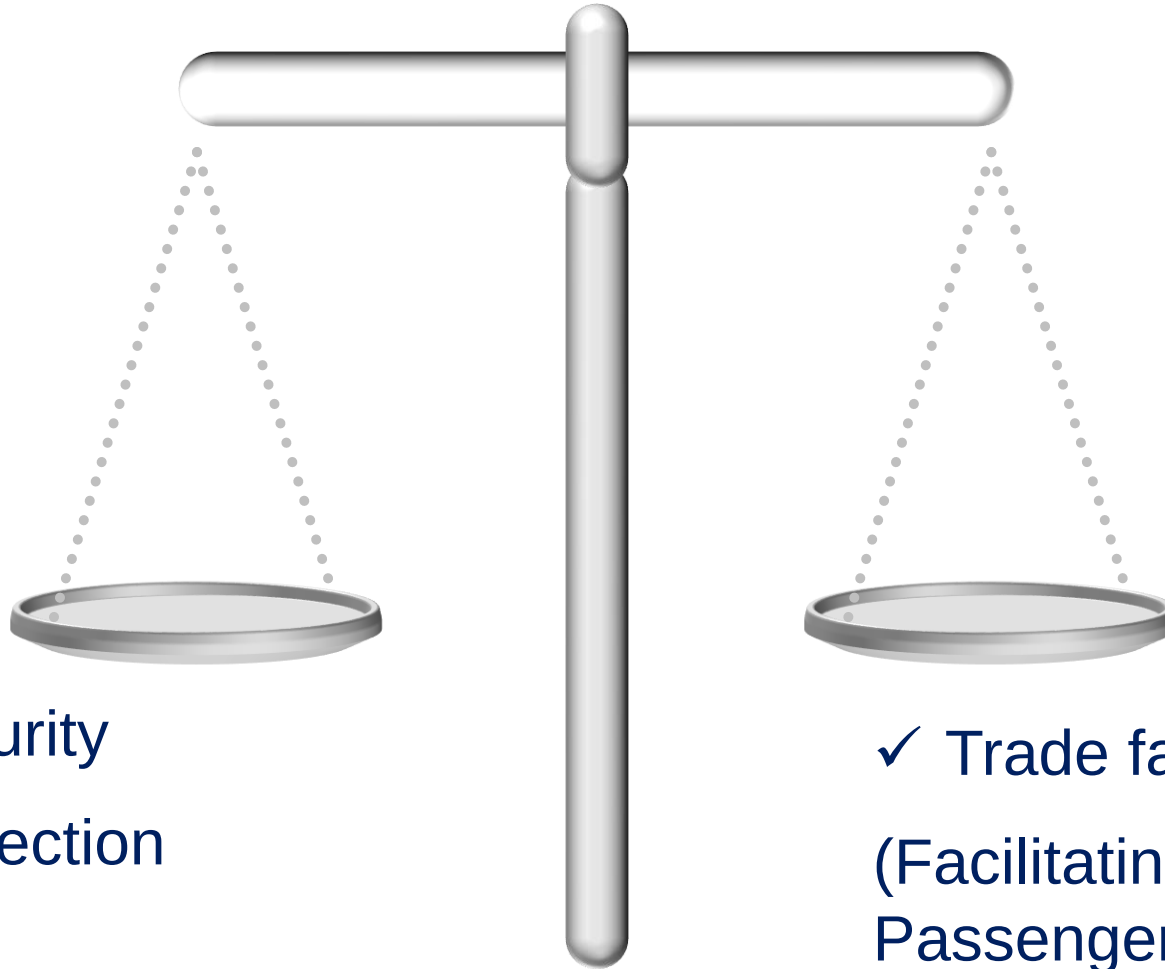

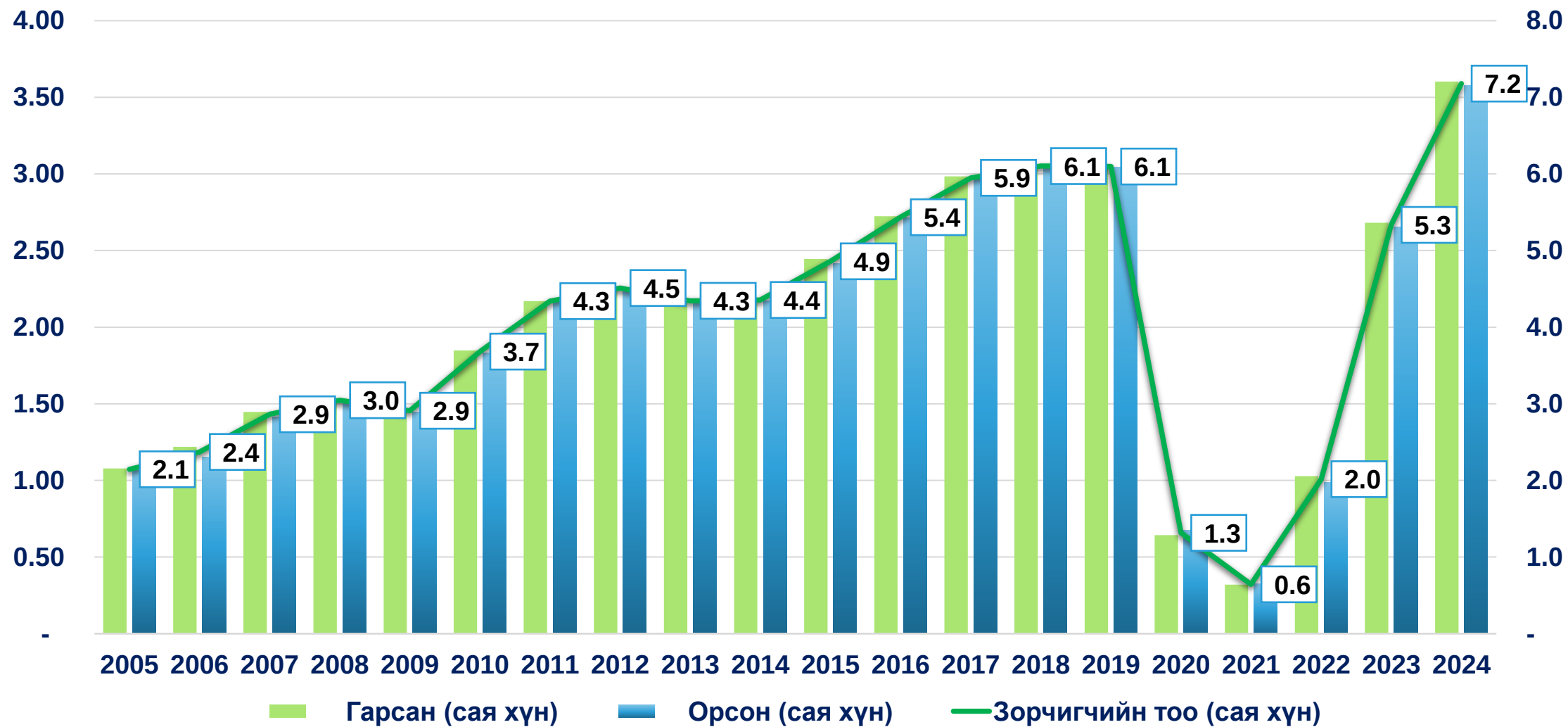

MONGOLIAN BORDERS

Total 39 borders:

- 16 ports bordering with Russia (active 10)
- 17 ports bordering with China
- Air: 6 borders (Chinggis Khaan, Ulgii, Choibalsan, Khovd, Khatgal, Ulaangom).

INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT

1

Border posts with completed infrastructure:

- ▶ Zamyn-Uud, Gashuunsukhait, Borshoo, Sukhbaatar border posts, A one-stop government service in the Khoshig Valley.
- ▶ Customs central and branch laboratory- 11, Training center for shepherd dogs-1

Infrastructure under construction:

- ▶ Altanbulag and Bichigt border posts' infrastructure is under construction
- ▶ Under the AX5 BEST project, the renovation work at the Tsagaannuur and Bulgan border posts has begun.

- ▶ Gashuunsukhait border checkpoint AGV terminal



CUSTOMS REFORM

Renovation of technical equipment has been carried out:

- ▶ A unified rapid monitoring center has been established for customs offices and control sub-centers.
- ▶ X-ray device for inspecting passenger luggage- 7 ports
- ▶ Instruments for detecting narcotic and psychotropic substances - 11 ports



DIGITAL CUSTOMS

Digital transformation:

- ▶ The customs organization is gradually digitalizing its operations and providing 13 services to individuals and 33 services to businesses in electronic form.
- ▶ It has become possible to exchange electronic information with 35 government and non-government organizations.

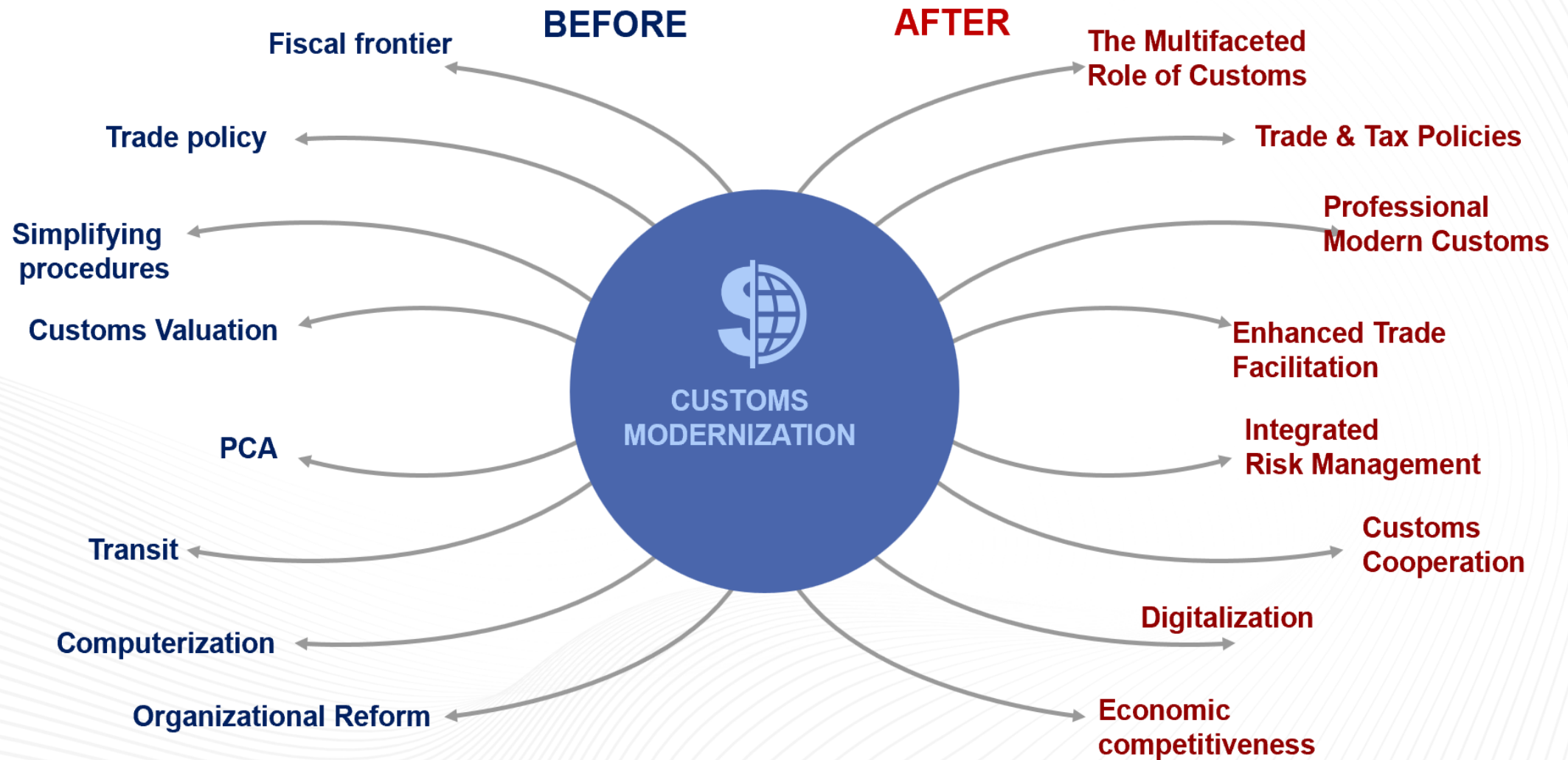
