## Hunnu Air Mobile App

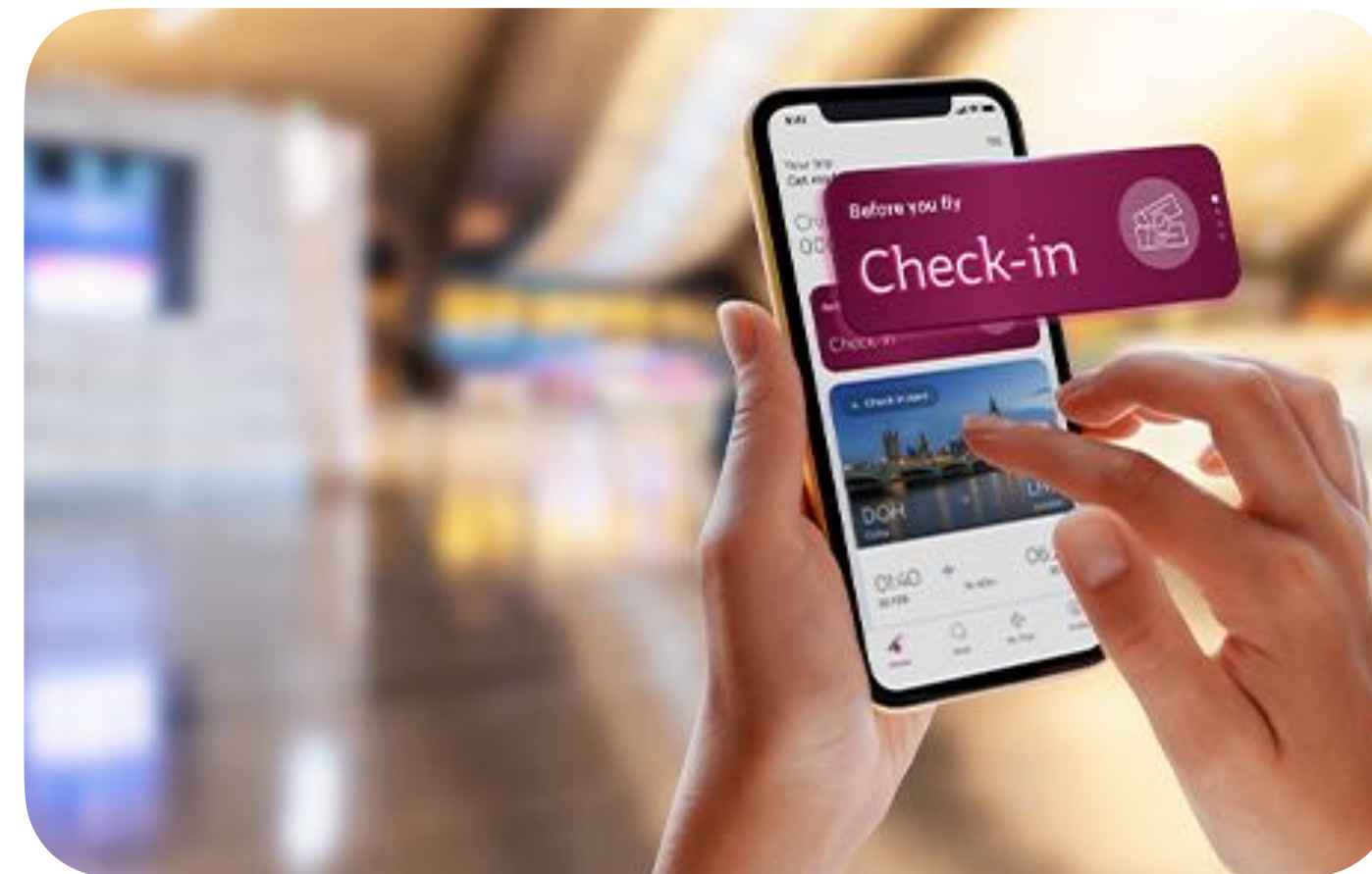


