Facilitation is a multi-stakeholder effort – NATFC can be leveraged on beyond compliance to Annex 9



- Alignment from multiple entities across various areas is challenging.
- Need to establish an effective platform that is engaging, relevant and collaborative.

ICAO Annex 9, Standards 8.15 -

Each State shall establish a National Air Transport Facilitation Committee (NATFC), and Airport Facilitation Committee as required, for the purpose of coordinating facilitation activities between departments, agencies, and other organizations of the State concerned with, or responsible for, various aspects of international civil aviation as well as with airport and aircraft operators.

- But is NATFC just about compliance to Annex 9?
- Singapore has reaped significant benefits from the set up of NATFC since 2012 to optimise the ecosystem.


