# IP/1 - ECAC Recommendations on Unaccompanied Minors



- **3.76 Recommended Practice**
- *In emergency situations resulting from force majeure, Contracting States, aircraft operators and airport operators should give priority assistance to those passengers with medical needs, unaccompanied minors and persons with disabilities who have already commenced their journeys.*

- Definitions.
- Information exchange between public authorities and aircraft operators to safeguard minors.
- Completion of an unaccompanied minors declaration form prior to carriage.

# IP/1 - ECAC Recommendations on Unaccompanied Minors



- There is no standardised unaccompanied minors declaration form.
- Authorisation and notarisation.
- The collection and use of statistics.
