Article 37

(Adoption of International Standards and Procedures)

- 1.Each State undertakes to collaborate in securing . . . uniformity . . . in regulations, standards . . . in all matters in which such uniformity will facilitate & improve air navigation.
- 2.ICAO required to adopt SARPs . . .
 - (j) Customs & immigration procedures . . .
 - & such other matters concerned with the . . . regularity & efficiency of air navigation . . .

Obligations of Users: Articles 10, 11, 13, 29, 35

A38 Declaration on Aviation Security

States . . . promote the use of cooperation mechanisms . . . for early detection and dissemination of information on security threats through the use of API and PNR as an aid to security

ANNEX 9: "SARPS" MEANING

Standard

Any specification, the <u>uniform observance</u> of which has been recognized as practicable and as <u>necessary</u> to facilitate and improve some aspect of international air navigation, which has been adopted by the Council pursuant to Article 54 (I) . . , and in respect of which <u>non-compliance must be notified</u> by Contracting States . . . in accordance with **Article 38**.



Recommended Practice

Any specification, the <u>observance</u> of which has been recognized as generally practicable and as <u>highly desirable</u> to facilitate and improve some aspect of international air navigation, which has been adopted by the Council pursuant to Article 54 (I) . . ., and to which Contracting States will <u>endeavour to conform</u> in accordance with the Convention.

C. ANNEX 9: AMENDMENT PROCESS


Art. 37: ICAO required to adopt and amend, from time-to-time, SARPs . . . (j) Customs & immigration procedures . . .

Art. 54(Mandatory functions of Council) The Council shall:

- (I) Adopt SARPs . . . (Annexes) . . . notify States of action taken
- (m) Consider recommendations for amendments

Art. 90: 2/3rds vote; effective 3 months after submission to States unless majority disapprove

Article 38: Departures from international standards and procedures

. . . In the case of amendments to international standards, any State which does not make the appropriate amendments to its own regulations . . shall give notice to the Council within sixty days of the adoption of the amendment to the international standard . . .
