What is the USAP-CMA?

- Builds on the success of the first two cycles of aviation security audits
- Objective is to promote global aviation security through continuous auditing and monitoring
- USAP activities assess:
 - Capability to provide appropriate national oversight; and
 - Compliance with Annex 17 Standards and security-related provisions in Annex 9

State's Aviation Security Performance Indicators




Oversight Indicators

- The State's level of implementation of the critical elements of an aviation security oversight system


Compliance Indicators

Targeting Assistance and Measuring Success



- USAP audit results are used, together with other information, to identify States for assistance
- Audit information also helps to target specific areas of a State's aviation security oversight systems that would benefit from ICAO-led assistance.
- Assistance may take the form of State Improvement Plans (SIPs), one-off training or consulting, or regional assistance programmes
- Once assistance has been delivered, USAP audits can be used to measure the impact of the assistance and actions taken by the targeted State



Cooperating with AVSEC partners

- AVSEC partners assist through the funding of assistance activities
- The provision of State-seconded officers to work with ICAO is also very beneficial
- Creating Cooperative Aviation Security Programmes (CASPs) to pursue mutually desirable security outcomes has also proven effective
- State performance indicators generated through the USAP can also be used by donor States to target areas for bilateral assistance
