

- Supporting the improvement of global Runway Safety performance through technical assistance projects and programs:
 - IATA is a partner in the multi-stakeholder Runway Safety Programme;
- Promoting the regular exchange of safety-relevant information:
 - IATA has been providing safety related information to regional offices, with the view of supporting Regional Aviation Safety Groups (RASGs);
 - IATA has been providing STEADES airport analysis to regional offices, with the view of supporting the Runway Safety Go-Teams;
- Regional Runway Safety Seminars and Workshops:
 - IATA has conducted and supported regional runway safety seminars;

Runway Safety Programme

- Production of tools and products, in collaboration with the industry IATA has developed:
 - The 2nd Runway Excursion Risk Reduction Toolkit;
 - A number of guidance materials for the prevention, and mitigation risks and errors;

- IATA has developed
 - Animations featuring events, such as Unstable approach/deep landing;
 - An in-depth analysis of runway safety accidents is conducted in order to identify the factors that contribute to a runway safety event;
 - Safety Performance Indicators to assess safety performance through monitoring and to identify areas for improvement.
