
Aviation and Climate Change: A Tale of Two Bubbles?

November 2020:

- Airline CEOs ask for more aid as passenger volumes remain 65 percent below 2019 levels
- UN Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) launches Race to Zero

UNEP Gap Report, 2019

- Unless global GHG emissions fall by 7.6 per cent each year 2020 to 2030, the world will miss the opportunity to get on track towards the 1.5°C temperature goal of the Paris Agreement.
- If we do nothing beyond our current, inadequate commitments to halt climate change, temperatures can be expected to rise 3.2°C above pre-industrial levels, with devastating effect.





