Hedberg serves as Director of the U.S. Department of Transportation's Office of International Aviation where he is responsible for promoting U.S. airline access to foreign markets and competition in international markets, reducing trade barriers and facilitating the export of domestic transportation goods and services, and licensing U.S. and foreign airlines to serve international markets.

He previously served as Assistant Director for Negotiations where he was responsible for bilateral civil aviation relations and negotiations with countries around the world. He works closely with the Departments of State, Commerce and Homeland Security to resolve issues that arise for U.S. and foreign air carriers conducting international air transportation, and contributes to the Department's international aviation initiatives.

Prior to joining the Office of International Aviation, he practiced immigration law in Chicago and worked with several legal assistance foundations. Mr. Hedberg received his Juris Doctor and a Certificate of International and Comparative Law from DePaul University and completed undergraduate education at Tulane University and Complutensis University of Madrid.
