2.	Visit the Nigerian Immigration Portal Select your country and begin the <u>Visa on Arrival Program</u>
3.	Delegates who require visa should, obtain their entry visas from the nearest Embassy/High Commission maintained by the Government of Nigeria.
4.	Gather Requirements Prepare all required documents for the visa application: □ Passport valid for at least 6 months with 2 blank pages for endorsement. □ International Passport Biodata page of each delegate. □ Flight itinerary of each delegate. □ Booked hotel /other documentary evidence of accommodation. □ A letter of Invitation from the Nigerian Civil A viation Authority (NCAA) accepting

Fill the Online Visa Form with the following accurate applicant details:

- Nationality
- Passport number
- Purpose of visit (i.e., Delegate to the ICAO Air Services Negotiation Event 2022 (ICAN2022) in Abuja, Nigeria)
- Proposed date of visit
- Proposed port of entry
- Flight itinerary
- o Address in Nigeria (i.e., Hotel information)

Upload the following documents:

- o Copy of Passport Data Page.
- o Copy of Airline Return ticket.
- Evidence of Accommodation

6. Print the final confirmation page with your Application ID and Reference Number.

7. Proceed to online payment

8. Approval

Approval which is valid for two (2) weeks from Date of Arrival would be sent as email.

Print approval and combine it with all other requirements before you travel to Nigeria.
