

FACT

Technology evolves at a fast rate



Evolution of Challenges is faster!!!

AUCTORIZO (medieval Latin)

Lesson 1

- Users should define problems
- Let responders specify solution
 - Very often Tenders over specify the requirements
 - Leaves little scope for responders to suggest alternatives

AUCTORIZO (medieval Latin)

Lesson 2

- Tendency to go with big boys
 - How much does your business mean to the responder
 - How much of their current work is relevant to your needs

AUCTORIZO (medieval Latin)

Lesson 3

- Collaborative effort
 - Too often the tendency to go it alone and expect other to follow
 - In grouping, the dominant voice sets the pace

Lesson 4

- Utility based pricing
 - Different from lease or right to use
 - E.g. Cloud Services
- Investment by provider Operational expense for user

Lesson 5

- Strategic Benchmarking
 - Cross Industry
 - Intra Industry
 - Learn from a related field of work
 - Lowers development cost and time

AUCTORIZO (medieval Latin)

Strategic Benchmarking – cross industry

- ICAO Regulatory framework to secure Air Cargo Supply Chain
 - regulated agent and known consignor regimes

 WCO SAFE framework of standards to secure and facilitate Global trade

Strategic Benchmarking – cross industry

Information flow between different stakeholders in the supply chain through following documents

- Invoice
- Packing List
- Certificate or Origin
- Dangerous Goods Declaration
- Air waybill
- House Cargo Manifest
- Export Goods Declaration
- Customs release export
- Air Cargo Security Declaration
- Air Cargo flight Manifest
- Export Cargo Declaration
- Import Cargo Declaration
- Import Goods Declaration
- Customs Release Import

AUCTORIZO (medieval Latin)

Strategic Benchmarking – cross industry

- Total of 14 documents
 - Not printed on secure paper. So, open to forgery.
 - The documents signatory could be any employee in the value chain. His authority to sign and by extension, the identity of the originator of the content is unknown.
 - Could be modified in transit no tamper evidence

Strategic Benchmarking – cross industry

- Learn from E-MRTD program
 - Working towards using 2D barcodes with digitally signed content
 - Protection of document without a chip evidence of origin and authenticity
 - Tamper evidence
 - Existing infrastructure in place incremental cost for a huge benefit

Strategic Benchmarking – intra industry

Visa is one aspect of facilitation

Challenges

- Locate embassy may not be in your country of residence
- Locate correct form to apply online information is often confusing
- Data requirements may vary
- Visa types not consistent across countries
- Passport needs to be sent to Embassy for duration of processing
- Visa dependencies
- Fee payment takes different forms

Current E-Visa regimes

- Apply online on per country basis
- After approval, you get a "reference number"
- Airline checkin counters and immigration need online lookup to verify your visa
- Alternately, visa is printed on plain piece of paper easy to forge as no security features

Strategic Benchmarking – intra industry

Possible Solution

Learn from Aircraft Registry and MRTD

- Single portal
 - Easy to apply for multiple countries simultaneously
 - Visa dependencies can be programmed into system
 - Backend integration with country systems
 - Common standards on data capture
- Use digitally signed 2D bar code to print visa information
 - Secure
 - Tamper Evident
 - Interoperable
 - Offline

Strategic Benchmarking – cross industry

 Aircraft Navigation Systems and communications are currently not protected – Need for Encryption/Authentication and multi party channel/credential management.

 TV Set-Top boxes use Encryption and multi party channel/credential management – starting point for Aircraft Navigation systems

Summary

- A collaborative effort among stakeholders which include Users, Industry and regulatory body along with centralised systems that are run on a utility pricing will be the best way to overcome challenges of the future.
- Do not re-invent the wheel Somebody somewhere has done it. Use it to build your solution
