Mr. Wang Yuanzheng is a senior officer in the Economic Policy Section, Air Transport Bureau, International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO). He has nearly 30 years of experience and extensive knowledge in international air transport regulation. He is currently the Secretary of the ICAO Air Transport Regulation Panel and the coordinator and author of the recent ICAO Secretariat study on the safety and security implications of economic liberalization.
