- Statistics of China's Civil Aviation Industry in 2005
 - ✓ total air traffic volume: 26.13 billion t/k
 - ✓ fleet: 863 airplanes
 - ✓ civil transport airports: 142
 - ✓ international air routes: 233

II. Impacts of Progressive Liberalization of International Air Transport

- Increased awareness and capabilities of competition of Chinese carriers;
- Promoted development of national and local economy;
- Provided more business opportunities for foreign carriers;
- Strengthened bilateral and multilateral relations with other countries and regions;
- Made its due contributions to the liberalization process of international air transport.

China-Korea Air Transport Market in 2005

- passenger traffic scored 6.35 million person times
- cargo traffic exceeded 300 thousand tons
- 30 Chinese cities and 6 Korean cities with air links

China-Korea Economic Ties

- The annual growth rate of bilateral trade volume has been up to 26.5%
- China is Korea's largest trade partner, export market and investment destination.
- Korea is China's third largest trade partner.
