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Chicago Convention, 1944



The aims and objectives of the Organization are to develop the principles and techniques of international air navigation and to foster the planning and development of international air transport (emphasis added) so as to:



Chicago Convention (cont)



- a) Insure the safe and orderly growth of international civil aviation throughout the world;
- b) Meet the needs of the peoples of the world for safe, regular, efficient and economical air transport;
- c) Prevent economic waste caused by unreasonable competition;
- d) Insure that the rights of contracting States are fully respected and that every contracting State has a fair opportunity to operate international airlines



Vision and Mission Statement ICAO

- The International Civil Aviation Organization, a UN Specialized Agency, is the global forum for civil aviation
- ICAO works to achieve its vision of Safe, Secure and Sustainable development of civil aviation through cooperation among its member States
- To implement this vision, the Organization has established the following strategic objectives for 2005-2010












Strategic Objective C: Minimize the adverse effect of global civil aviation on the environment

 - limit or reduce the impact of aircraft engine emissions on local air quality
 - •limit or reduce the impact of aviation greenhouse gas emissions on the global climate

Strategic Objective A : Safety

- Provide denominator data & safety indicators.
- Collaborate with ANB and SSA Branch to facilitate provision of safety data and trend analysis.
- Provide safety data for briefings to ANC and ICAO Press Releases.
- Analyze statistical relationship between audit findings and accident rates.



Strategic Objective "C": Environment



- Support the work of the CAEP and its Forecasting and Economic Analysis
 Support Group (FESG):
 - Provide Statistics, Traffic and Fleet forecasts
 - Develop and revise forecast methodologies
 - Economic Analyses of Policy Options





- Collect, process, analyze and disseminate civil aviation statistics
- Maintain web-enabled Integrated Statistical database
- Analyze regional differences in international airline operating economics to assist in the evaluation of the impact of regulatory change
- Support proration of passenger revenues from interline journeys and settlement of accounts between postal administrations in respect of air conveyance





- Provide passenger/freight traffic flows, aircraft movement forecasts and other planning parameters for the decision-making process of ICAO, Contracting States and PIRGs (2 TFG meetings per year).
- Develop cost effectiveness analyses and business cases in support of planning and implementation of air navigation systems.
- Provide high level and benchmark indicators for monitoring performance.



- Little progress made in carrying out public policy

AIR TRANSPORT BUREAU (ATB)

The Air Transport Bureau (click to view the Structure) is involved in work carried out towards the implementation of the Strategic Objectives of ICAO especially objectives B - Security, C - Environmental Protection, D - Efficiency and E - Continuity. The Bureau works under the direction of the Air Transport Committee, the Committee on Unlawful Interference and the Committee on Joint Support of Air Navigation Services and to this end it fulfils the following functions:

- o provides expert assistance required by the Assembly, Council, Air Transport Committee (ATC), Committee on Unlawful Interference (UIC), Committee on Joint Support of Air Navigation Services (JSC) and the specialized conference, divisional, panel and working group meetings that may be convened in the air transport field:
- provides economic advice to other bodies and Bureaux of the Organization, particularly the Committee on Aviation Environmental Protection (CAEP), the Air Navigation Bureau (ANB), and the Technical Co-operation Bureau (TCB);
- prepares studies and develops recommendations for policy quidance in the fields concerned;
- prepares procedural documentation concerning amendments to Annexes 9 — Facilitation and 17 — Security to the Convention and the compilation of lists of differences to these Annexes which are notified by Contracting States;
