1) WHY COMPETENCY BASED TRAINING?



Background



>Traditional Inspector's training:

- This approach for inspector training has been mostly based on sole requirements and very prescriptive.
- This regional approach emphasized documentation and programme review as the only means to measure operational safety.





>Inspector's requirements:

- Licensing
- Experience
- Training

Inspector's Competency-based framework and training




- Competency Framework is an effective method to assess, maintain, and monitor the Knowledge, Skills, and Attitudes of inspectors in Civil Aviation Authorities.
- Review of current inspector's training programme to incorporate competency based training and assessment methodology, in that way, our inspectors will be trained in a performance orientation, with emphasis on standards of performance and their measurement.



Five Training Steps



- 1) An inspector proves to be proficient in all areas assessed (skills, knowledge and attitudes)
- 2) The inspector moves to the OJT phase where she/he will demonstrates what has been learned
- 3) The application of rules and procedures is standardized







3) Regional Challenges and Achievements





- ➤ RPAs competency: Using the five steps, the regional training focuses on the competency for civil aviation inspectors (skills, knowledge and attitudes) to achieve this standard.
- ➤ To be competent, the regional and national inspector needs to demonstrate the ability to perform tasks and duties to the standard expected in order to carry out his/her obligations.





Benefits of a regional regulation and training programmes



- Harmonization of certification and surveillance programmes to supervise RPAS operations.
- This will facilitate RPAS operators to train their pilots with the benefits of regional license recognition.
