Ms. Lilian Fong is a Senior Operations Officer of the Hong Kong Civil Aviation Department currently taking charge of the implementation of the Hong Kong Safety Programme.

Her past experience includes the handling of air services matters, aviation statistics, schedule coordination and heliport project management. In 2006-07, she was seconded as advisor to the Permanent Mission of China to the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) in Montreal.

In 2008-09, Ms. Fong took charge of legal and international relations matters and was heavily involved in the drafting of the two Conventions on compensation for damages to third parties which were adopted by Diplomatic Conference. She also served as the coordinator of the legal amendment exercise for the Air Navigation (Hong Kong) Order.

From 2009 to 2010, Ms. Fong was posted to the Airport Standards Division to take charge of the Dangerous Goods Office.

In 2011, she took up safety oversight duties for the Hong Kong International Airport, providing advice on licensing and safety management issues as well as the monitoring of airfield enhancement projects.

Ms. Fong took up the current post in the Strategic Safety Office in 2017 and is responsible for coordinating strategic safety oversight activities and continuous monitoring of departmental safety regulatory activities.
