She rose through the ranks of the Gambian Civil Aviation Authority (GCAA) to the post of Director General and Chief Executive Officer of the Authority where she was responsible for the full range of aviation regulatory activities. She also performed the role of Head of Secretariat for the Banjul Accord Group Aviation Safety Oversight Organisation (BAGASOO) formerly known as the Banjul Accord Group (BAG). Mrs. Taal Ndure served in various positions within the GCAA and as Consultant and Adviser with ICAO.

Mrs. Taal Ndure is a recipient of the 2007 Flight Safety Foundation President's Citation for her work in improving aviation safety in Africa. She is a British citizen with Gambian nationality and married to Mr. Ebrima Ousmane Ndure, a native of the Gambia. She has two children.
