Mandate

- Maastricht Ministerial Council 2003
 - ~ ICAO minimum security standards for Handling & Issuance
 - ~ Issuance of 9303 standard MRTDs, if possible with digitized photos
 - ~ On voluntary basis, also supports issuance of ePassports with biometrics



Mandate

- Sofia Ministerial Council 2004
 - ~ Report lost & stolen travel documents, either blank or personalized to Interpol
- Brussels Ministerial Council 2006
 - ~ Support deployment of FIND & MIND to provide first-line law enforcement end-users real-time access to Interpol's databases



Core Tasks and Partners

- Provide political platform for IOs
- Facilitate the work of major specialized agencies













- Handling & Issuance
- MRTDs, digitised photos and ePassports
- Interpol's databases for law enforcement end-users
- Detecting falsified and fraudulent documents

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
Handling and Issuance

- Highlight importance of H&I especially in regard to Counter-Terrorism
- High assurance in enrolment & adjudication process
- Reduce possibility of issuing fraudulent documents
- Support comprehensive civil registration systems Specific issues:
 - Transliteration
 - National harmonization of breeder documents

- Raise awareness for use of ASF-SLTD
- Institutionalize regular & rapid reporting of documents
- Link national databases to Interpol's databases
- Facilitate deployment of technical platforms:
 - Fixed Interpol Network Database FIND
 - Mobile Interpol Network Database MIND
