# Background

- Significant time and resources has gone into the development of Doc 9303 specifications
- Despite this investment States have no ability to fully test whether MRTDs comply
- Clear need in TD community that is not being met



# Proposal

- ICAO shall offer a Doc 9303 Compliance Programme to Member States or vendors
- Fee based programme shall be agreed upon by Member States
- Scheme issues certificates of compliance and non-compliance notices



## Proposal (2)

- ICAO shall own and manage the Doc 9303 Compliance Programme
- Use existing MRTD certification services offered by test authorities and individual experts (must be endorsed by ICBWG)
- Initially limited to MRPs and eMRPS



# Target Scenarios

- Issuing authority or vendor that wishes to verify Doc 9303 compliance of an existing (e)MRTD
- Issuing authority is going to market and wants the vendors to ensure Doc 9303 compliance and certification as part of the contract award and/or the delivery phase

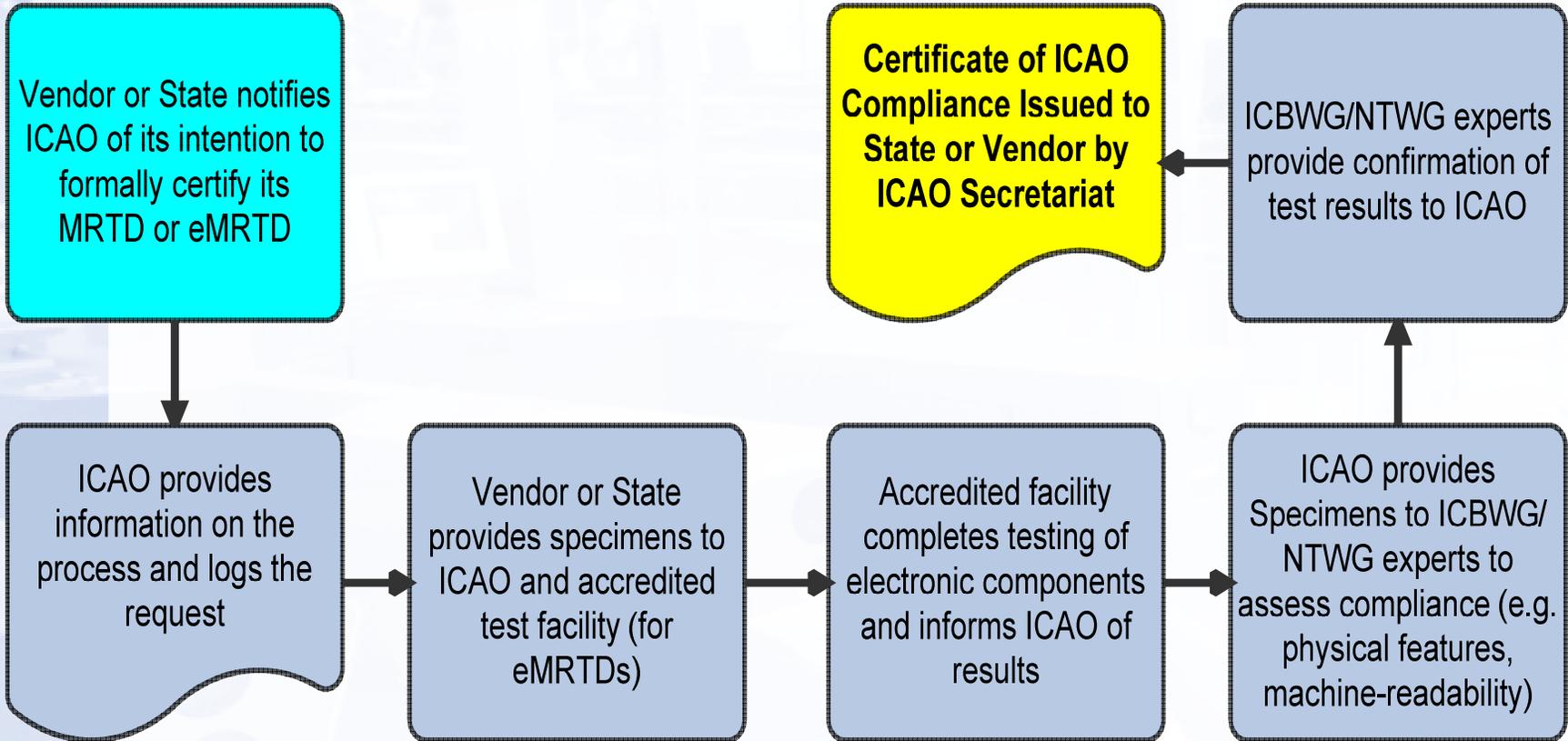


# Roles

- ICAO – Administrator
- ICBWG – Support
- Test Laboratory – Test Authority
- Experts – Experience based analysis, particularly for evaluation of physical features (e.g. security)
