

Process to become ICAO Qualified Instructors instructor qualification and requirements

- 1. Successfully complete the course
- Successfully complete the TRAINAIR PLUS Training Instructors Course (TIC)
- 3. Deliver the training course under the supervision of a ICAO Senior Qualified Instructor (on-the-job training)



Process to become ICAO Qualified Instructors instructor specific requirements

- Subject-Matter Expert (SME)
- Prior experience
- Recent experience at the operational level
- Extensive knowledge on the existing regulation;
- Proven instructor


