
## IOM at a glance



- The UN Migration Agency, 169 Member States
- Focus on project and programme implementation
- Solid capacity to implement large-scale technical assistance projects round the world
- Scale of programming: 2760 projects with total budget USD 1.6 Billion (2016)
- Worldwide presence:
  - offices in over 150 States and 400 field locations.
  - almost 11,000 IOM staff
- Demonstrated ability to deliver results in developing, fragile and security-phased countries
- IOM's IBM portfolio: total current budget USD 220 Million and 205 projects



### IOM Support to ICAO TRIP Strategy Implementation



- IOM-ICAO MoU in November 2016
- Focus on technical assistance projects in supporting States in ICAO TRIP Strategy implementation
- IOM Action Plan for ICAO TRIP Implementation Assistance for the 2018-2020 Triennium
- A major focus area: passenger data (mainly API) implementation assistance





## ICAO SECURITY & FACILITATION Current projects



- Western Balkans Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Montenegro and Serbia: legal and IT assessments, regional technical consultations; validation workshops on assessment results, forming and facilitating national API working groups – close coop with OSCE
- Ukraine: technical consultations, developing APIS procurement
- Georgia: API legislation, API working group, technical consultations, workshops, RFI and tender management, analytics
- Azerbaijan: API/PNR training for government authorities
- Turkmenistan: API/PNR legal assessment; API training co-funded and coorganized with OSCE.

## Close cooperation and coordination with partners

















#### Three core areas:

- **Understanding API/PNR:** advocacy, workshops, technical consultations
- Implementing APIS: managing a procurement tender or services/equipment
- Exploiting API/PNR: analytics and risk management capabilities

#### Including, in particular

- Developing an implementation plan
- Legislative review and developing API legislation
- Creating a National API Working Group
- Assessments: technical, legal, etc
- Privacy and data protection cross cutting activities

## Main areas of assistance

#### Challenges and lessons learned

- Misconceptions about API/PNR
- Inter-agency cooperation: a lead agency and Single Window
- Sustainability: data service fees
- Privacy and data protection: not just legislation
- Needs assessment the foundation of success
- Need for an exit strategy when using data services
- Managing change
- Contact with carriers
- Vendor-driven API/PNR implementation need for impartial technical advice
- Interoperability and data quality
- APIS implementation, API and ETA need for guidance material
