The working group is leading standardization activities specifically for Europe in the field of Breeder Documents. It includes, but is not restricted to, data collection, application, issuance and renewal processes



#### Breeder Documents also known as Foundational Documents

Documents used to support applications for identity, residence and travel documents, such as birth, marriage and death certificates.

- Breeder Document standardisation supports ICAO TRIP Guide on Evidence of Identity objectives
- Informally requested by the EU after funding of 2 projects on Breeder Documents and Passport confidence / security
  - ORIGINS
  - FIDELITY

Principle 1 Identity is Genuine

Objective A To determine if the Identity exists(i.e. is not fictitious)

Objective B To determine the identity



## TRIP2023

#### A secure credential is worth little if the data is not reliable

- Definition of each data-field
- Source of the data
- Vetting of the data
- Monitoring of the processes and enforcing rules

#### Informed Trust develops based on knowledge and shared values

Civil Registration is heterogeneous and potentially non-transparent in matters of daily interoperability

"No entity can enforce a specific regulation or SOPs for Civil Registry on other administrations"

#### Trust establishment and management processes **Reporting and Processing**

#### Reporting (Chapter 5)

(...)requires the implementing and operating bodies to undergo a formal and structured approach in setting governance and policy on one hand, and monitoring of the execution on the other hand.

#### Process (Chapter 5.1)

- 1. Review checklist for completeness
- 2. ["OBJECTIVE"]: Review the checklist and the referenced resources together with the stakeholders, and decide on the individual elements being a compulsory requirement for your implementation, or not. Record your reasoning respectively your justification of the decision.
- 3. ["RECOMMENDATION"]: If considered compulsory, discuss and define the specific implementation considering the referenced resources. Should alternative standards or guidance be followed, clearly describe such process.
- 4. Conduct a gap-analysis and document. Classify deviations to be deliberate/permanent, or - if not - what the roadmap for closing the deviation is going to be.
- 5. ["IMPLEMENTATION"]: Compile an informational report suitable for cross-agency / cross-border information relative to the implemented processes and the resulting data-quality.


