

✈ The Secretary General is head of the Secretariat, Chief Executive Officer of the Organization and Secretary of the Council


✈ The Secretariat has five Bureaus:

- Legal Bureau (LEB)






ICAO Regional Offices

- ➔ Standard and Recommended Practices (SARPs) (18 Annexes)
Manuals, Policies, Guidance Material, etc.
- ➔ Audit the States (USOAP/CMA, USAP)
- ➔ Assisting States

TCB Main Objectives

- States' compliance with ICAO SARPs
- Strengthening of civil aviation institutions
- Transfer of technology and development of human resources





TCB's Areas of Projects

- Assist States with experts to strengthen civil aviation institutions
- Training national experts with the development of human resources
- Procurements of services and goods with the corresponding transfer of technology



Infrastructure and Procurement Services

- Aerodromes
- Air navigation systems and equipment
- Security systems and equipment
- Airport management systems
- Maintenance programmes





ICAO Technical Co-operation / Programme

150 Projects in 96 Countries + 20 Regional Projects, total coverage 120 countries
