27-29 June 2017, Addis Ababa, Ethiopia

Dokisime Gnana Latta is the Director General of National Civil Aviation Administration (NCAA) of the Togolese Republic. Latta is ATPL Pilot and head of operational resources Transport Base of Lomé; Transport Base Commander of Lomé and Base Commander Acting Transport Lomé. He was the Minister of Security and Civil Protection for Togo. Among other high profile posts he occupied include President of AMCAA (African and Malagasy Civil Aviation Authority); Vice-President of the African Civil Aviation Commission (AFCAC); and Chairman of the Board of TOGOTELECOM. At the first International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) meeting on Air Cargo Development in Africa held in Lomé, Togo in August 2014, Latta was elected unanimously as the Chairman of the meeting. He also heads the monitoring committee of the Lomé action plan and will report the implementation of the action plan in the second ICAO Meeting on Air Cargo Development in Africa to be held in Addis-Ababa, Ethiopia in 2017.
