



- Airports and other aviation stakeholders play a key role in the deployment of biofuels - it is not about the amount of biofuel currently available at airports, but the joint commitment for the future. States need to recognise this.
- Biofuels are part of a basket of measures. Airports are already taking action through the Airport Carbon Accreditation initiative to work with others to manage and reduce their emissions and even become carbon neutral. States should avoid introducing regulations which lead to market distortion.
- States should consult and work with all stakeholders in developing and implementing new initiatives
