SUMMARY

This document contains the position on transparency of information on the results of inspections in the field of aviation security.

Action: High-level Conference on Aviation Security is invited to endorse the conclusions stated in in paragraph 5.2 of the materials presented by the Secretariat on the evolution of the auditing process in the aviation security.

1. **INTRODUCTION**

- 1.1 Access to Member States to ICAO information on audit results, on the one hand, increase the level of safety, the preparation for the implementation of which will be based on possible risk analysis and, on the other hand, would be an additional incentive to actively correct the inconsistencies to international standards in the field of aviation safety identified in the States;
- 1.2 In order to ensure the confidentiality of the information it is necessary to limit access to a secure USAP website (http://icaosec.icao.int) for those member states of ICAO, where ICAO experts couldn't conducted planned audits for security reasons or that are under United Nations sanctions because of unstable military and political situation.

2. CONCLUSION

- 2.1 High-level Conference on Aviation Security recommends acceptance of the Secretariat that the information includes diagrams illustrating the lack of effective implementation of the EC, and all significant weaknesses in aviation security should be provided to Member States of ICAO (with restrictions specified in paragraph 1.2 of the working paper);
- Aviation Administration of the Republic of Belarus is ready to make the practical orientation of the process solution to consent to placing information on the 2010 ICAO Commission audit in the Republic of Belarus on aviation security on a secure website, to the extent specified in in paragraph 2.1.
