Competencies

Appropriate competencies with technical knowledge and skill for the specific sector.



Transparent Verification Process

Fair verification process, duration and its cost. Implement verification as planned with sufficient **data sampling**.



Safeguard Impartiality and Confidentiality

Communication of responsibility to a client, the records management and safeguarded confidentiality of information. Ensure safeguard impartiality through Mechanism for oversight of impartiality



Insurance and reserves

Arrangements (e.g. insurance, reserves) sufficient to cover liabilities arising from the activities and areas in which it operates.



Appeal, Complaints, and service improvement


Process to manage, evaluate, take necessary corrective action, and make decisions **on** appeals and complaint. Continuous improvement of service by internal audit and management review







IAF and IAF MLA activities for global acceptance verification statement



IAF MLA for ISO14065, have received peer evaluation by ISO/IEC 17011, ISO 14065, and relevant IAF documents, that provide trust and builds confidence among accreditation bodies through their ability to determine the competence of verification bodies, which in turn facilitates the acceptance of verification between states.

Visit onsite to evaluate the ability of verification



Accreditation



Surveillance annually then reaccreditation.







Office

Visit an office of verification body to evaluate the verification process and competencies are appropriate.






IAF: Regional Corporation and Accreditation

Summary



- IAF is a global organization of accreditation bodies, accredited verification bodies and organisations involved in conformity assessment activities. The accreditation bodies of IAF members are national accreditation bodies.
- Accreditation means third-party attestation related to a conformity assessment body conveying formal demonstration of its competence to carry out specific conformity assessment tasks.
- IAF members' accreditation process based on ISO/IEC 17011:2017. 32 IAF MLA members implement ISO14065 accreditation and received peer evaluation to ISO/IEC 17011 and ISO 14065: (Regional group. EA 25, PAC 6, IAAC 1) Total number of accredited verification bodies under IAF MLA for ISO14065 is 207 (EA 137, PAC 55, IAAC 55).
- IAF has structured IAF MLA for ISO14065 by developing a harmonised global approach for accreditation and maintaining the arrangements as to promotes trust and builds confidence among accreditation bodies through their ability to determine the competence of verification bodies and to assure accredited verification process consistent equal reliable.
- Supporting developing mandatory documents as the basis for the <u>IAF MLA to ensure the equal and</u> trustable accredited verification statement for global ICAO scheme.
- Supporting developing countries to establish an accreditation infrastructure for ISO14065 with local accreditation and verification bodies through capacity building trainings.


