American Carbon Registry

- Founded in 1996 as first private voluntary GHG registry & joined Winrock in 2007
 - Over 130 million tons of verified emissions reductions issued to date from offset project types:
 - Agriculture, Land Use and Forestry
 - Industrial Processes
 - Transportation Efficiency
 - Energy (renewables & efficiency, fuel switching)
- Approved in December 2012 as a California Offset Project Registry (OPR)
- Approved in 2017 to issue ACR offsets for nine project types for compliance with Washington Clean Air Rule





ICAO ENVIRONMENT ACR Roles

Ensure integrity throughout the value chain:

- 1) Develop and approve environmentally rigorous carbon offset accounting standards & methodologies
- 2) Oversee offset project registration
- 3) Oversee independent verification by accredited entities
- 4) Issue and track serialized offsets
- 5) Operate a transparent registry system

ACR Offset Credits

 Transacted in contracts with sellers (Over the Counter -OTC) – typically brokers or retailers

or

2. Transacted on exchange platforms that have linkage agreements with ACR

Whether transacted OTC or on an exchange, the credits are transferred on the registry or can be retired on behalf of a buyer (ie: an airline) in the seller's account






California Experience

Growing the Market

- Predictable, transparent, stable, rule-based market & consistent demand led to steady increase in volume
- Multiple registries provide options and increased supply
- 140 million tons issued (2013-2017)
- Four primary methodologies sourced from limited geography
