


- **Verification bodies of GHG emissions under the EU ETS Directive** must be accredited according to **ISO 14065** standard
- **About the accreditation:**
 - Granted by EU national accreditation bodies (e.g. **UKAS**)
 - Accreditation is **sector specific** (non-aviation accredited verifiers must also be accredited for aviation)
 - Accreditation process includes **witness verification audits**



Verification is about understanding the **data transformation process**







Main challenges of a verifier

- Size of **sampling** (*mitigated by the use of VEDAS*)
- Operator's **lack of preparation**, lack of knowledge, late contact (*no trend in size or location*)
- **Verifier's role** not always understood
- Major **amendments** to the applicable regulations
