2.2 Conference proceedings on 16 September 2008

- 2.2.1 The deliberations of agenda item 1.2 Economic performance and minimum reporting requirements were completed with the remainder of discussion and interventions from the floor. The Secretariat introduced agenda item 1.3 Consultation with users with the presentation of Secretariat WP/6. Subsequently, WPs/70, 22, 65, 53, 29, 35, 26, 47 and 24 (listed in order of presentation) were presented, in full or in part relevant to the agenda item under consideration by, and information papers WPs/41 and 64 were mentioned.
- 2.2.2 In the afternoon, the Secretariat introduced agenda item 2 Specific issues related to airport economics and management with the presentation of Secretariat WP/7 on agenda item 2.1 Ownership, governance and control. The respective State, group of States or observer organization issuing WPs/57, 59, 39, 22, 23 and 68 presented their working papers and the Chairman mentioned to note the relevant parts of information papers WPs/18, 19 and 42. On the basis of the documentation tabled the Conference started its deliberations of this agenda item.

2.3 **Draft reports by agenda item**
