- National and international trade
- Improvement of quality, safety, the environment and health
- Interoperability
- Access to markets
- Optimization of infrastructures
- The evaluation and demonstration of conformity



Aerospace industry standards

ISO/TC 20 Aircraft and space vehicles +600 published standards for :

- Design
- Construction
- Test and evaluation
- Operation
- Air traffic management
- Maintenance
- Disposal/end of life
- Safety, reliability and environmental considerations

ISO/TC 20 Sub-committees

- Aerospace electrical requirements
- Aerospace fastener systems
- Standard atmosphere
- Aerospace terminology
- Air cargo and ground equipment
- Aerospace fluid systems and components
- Space data and information transfer systems
- Space systems and operations

Airport infrastructure standards

- ISO/TC 20/SC17, Airport Infrastructure
- To cover all infrastructure unique to airport environment
- Development of International Standards such as:
 - Grooving of landing and take-off lanes
 - Asphaltic ecologic paving
 - Vertical signalling with painting and electric-electronic boards (painted and lighted signage)



Conformity assessment - Examples

ISO 55001 – Asset management

- Improve performance of infrastructure, streamline expenditure, strengthen credentials and future proof facilities
- Genève Aéroport first ISO 55001 certified airport in Europe

Carbon Offsetting Scheme for International Aviation (CORSIA)

- Monitor, report, and verify GHG emissions for international aviation
- In accordance with ICAO and ISO GHG standards
 - ISO 14065:2013 Greenhouse gases -- Requirements for greenhouse gas validation and verification bodies for use in accreditation or other forms of recognition
 - ISO 14064-3:2006 Greenhouse gases -- Part 3: Specification with guidance for the validation and verification of greenhouse gas assertions
- Endorsed by International Accreditation Forum (IAF) and ICAO
- Promotes multilateral recognition of Verification Bodies (VBs)
- Scheme will cover 80% of CO2 growth (2021-2035)
