Mr. HAN Jun was appointed as Director General of International Affairs Department of the Civil Aviation Administration of China (CAAC) in February 2012. Prior to that, he served as Deputy Director General of CAAC's International Affairs Department from March 2008 to February 2012. From

March 2007 to February 2008, Mr. Han worked as China's Alternate Representative on the Council of the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO). Mr. Han joined the CAAC in 1997 and had served as Deputy Division Chief and then Division Chief of Foreign Affairs of CAAC's Department of International Affairs & Cooperation. Before his public service with CAAC, Mr. Han taught at Jilin University of Technology in northeast China from 1991 to 1994.

Mr. Han acquired his Ph.D. degree in civil and commercial law from Renmin University of China in 2006. From 1994 to 1997, Mr. Han studied for his M.A. degree at Renmin University of China majoring in English and American Literature. Mr. Han graduated from Hunan University in 1991 with a B.A. degree.
