ECONOMIST, INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORT FORUM (ITF) OF THE OECD (ORGANISATION FOR ECONOMIC CO-OPERATION AND DEVELOPMENT)

Alain Lumbroso is an economist at the international Transport Forum (ITF) of the OECD (Organisation for Economic Co-Operation and Development), based in Paris, France. At the ITF, Mr. Lumbroso leads the organisation's research activities in aviation policy, particularly in

the fields of market liberalisation, competitiveness, air cargo and unmanned aircraft as well as tourism and supply chains. He is frequently invited to speak on issues linked with all these issues.

Mr. Lumbroso is on loan from the Canadian Ministry of Transport, Transport Canada, where he was the head of the Aviation and Maritime Statistics, Research and Analysis Unit. There he coordinated the department's policy exercise in air cargo, leading to 13 workshops on air cargo workshops across the country as well as 12 different research pieces looking at various air cargo policy issues. Mr. Lumbroso was also the Transport Canada representative on the ADAP working group and on the IATA e-Freight Business Working Group for Canada..
