econometrics and freight demand modelling. Previously, he worked as a researcher at the VU University of Amsterdam and as an air transport expert at the Ethiopian Civil Aviation Authority. His research works have been published in leading transportation economics journals like Journal of Transport Economics and Policy, Transportation Research Part A, and Part E. Some of his main ongoing researches include: economic analysis of EU's external aviation policy; development of Swedish National Freight Transport model; fuel price increases and the trucking industry performance; the costs and benefits of "Open Skies" policy in the East African Community.
