




Air Transport Growth in 2015*





- ✈ **3.5 billion passengers**
- ✈ **50 million tonnes of freight**
- ✈ **1 400 commercial airlines**
- ✈ **26 700 aircraft in service**
- ✈ **4 130 airports**
- ✈ **173 air navigation services providers**

Traffic is for scheduled services in 2015 (estimated)



Air Transport moves:

- Over half of 1.1 billion international tourists
- About 35 per cent of world trade by value

Air Transport contributes to:

- 8.5 million (directly) and 58.1 million (total) jobs
- \$700 billion (directly) and \$2.4 trillion (total) GDP



CHICAGO CONVENTION

Preamble

THEREFORE, the undersigned governments having agreed on certain principles and arrangements in order that international civil aviation may be developed in a safe and orderly manner and that international air transport services may be established on the basis of equality of opportunity and operated soundly and economically;

Article 44

...insure that the rights of contracting States are fully respected and that every contracting State has a fair opportunity to operate international airlines;
