Mr. Dueñas is a lawyer, (LL.B University of Chile, 1988, *summa cum laude*) and holds a Master Degree in Public Law. He has developed a 30 years career in civil aviation, having completed several specialization courses in Air and Space Law, Airport Regulation and Air Transport Policy, among others.

He has served as legal advisor to the Chilean DGCA, Head Attorney of the National Aircraft Registry and Head of the Legal Department of the Civil Aeronautics Board (CAB) of Chile. Currently he is the acting Secretary General of the CAB, where he is in charge of leading the negotiation of air services agreements and managing the national air commercial policy.

Within the framework of ICAO, he has been appointed in two occasions as Alternate Representative of Chile to the Council (2003 and 2013). During the 39th Assembly he was elected Vice President of the Economic Commission.

Since 1999 he is part of ICAO TCB's Legal Experts roster, having worked as a consultant for ICAO and UNDP technical cooperation projects in Latin America, the Caribbean and Africa, providing advisory in different matters of civil aviation.

As of 2015 he has been appointed as member of the Air Transport Regulation Panel (ATRP).
