Mrs Josephine Teo was appointed Senior Minister of State for Finance and Transport on 1 September 2013. She was Minister of State for Finance and Transport from 21 May 2011 to 31 Aug 2013.

On 1 Oct 2015, she relinquished her Finance portfolio, and was appointed Senior Minister of State, Prime Minister's Office to assist in overseeing the National Population and Talent Division in the Prime Minister's Office. She is concurrently the Senior Minister of State for Foreign Affairs and Transport.

A Member of Parliament since 2006, Mrs Teo was formerly Chairman of the Government Parliamentary Committee for Education and Assistant Secretary-General of the National Trades Union Congress (NTUC). She represented the labour movement on the government-appointed Economic Strategies Committee and co-chaired the sub-committee on Fostering Inclusive Growth. Mrs Teo was concurrently Chief Executive Officer of the not-for-profit organisation Business China, a platform launched by then Minister Mentor Lee Kuan Yew and then Chinese Premier Wen Jiabao to strengthen Singapore's bicultural foundations, and remains a member of its Board.

To enhance Singapore's position as a leading global air hub, Mrs Teo was appointed to chair a multi-agency '*Changi 2036 Steering Committee*' in 2012. This Committee provides strategic direction for the long-term growth plans of Changi Airport. She also chairs the Public Transport Tripartite Committee.
