## **ROHAN GARIB**

### **Executive Manager Air Navigation Services** Trinidad and Tobago Civil Aviation Authority (TTCAA)

Mr. Rohan Garib started his world of work in 1994 at the Ministry of Transportation, Motor Vehicles Division. In 1999 under the same Ministry of Transportation, he started his aviation career at the Civil Aviation Division as an Air Traffic Controller in Tower Operations. Following this he moved on to be an Air Traffic Controller in Area Control Operations. He also served as an On the Job training Instructor in Tower Operations and served at the TTCAA's Civil Aviation Training Centre.

His Management Career started in 2009 when he was asked to perform the functions of Coordinator of the Caribbean Air Navigation Advisory Service. In 2010 he was given the task to set up the Department of Economic Regulations to take over the functions of the Air Transport Licensing Authority and was promoted to Manager Economic Regulations. In 2012 he was asked to be the Project Manager for the transition of staff and services to the new TTCAA's Aviation Complex. During that same year he was promoted to the post of Executive Manager Air Navigation Services.

On a Regional Level, he represents Trinidad and Tobago as the Rapporteur/Chairman of the Eastern Caribbean Civil Aviation Technical Group, Search and Rescue (SAR) Committee; Member of the Trinidad and Tobago's Search and Rescue Region's Working Group for Aeronautical and Maritime SAR, involving Barbados, Grenada and St Vincent and the Grenadines; Vice Chairman of the ICAO North American Central American and Caribbean, Air Navigation Implementation Working Group and the Chairman of the Caribbean Aviation Safety and Security Oversight Systems, Air Navigation Services Standing Committee.

His qualifications includes several certifications in Aviation and has been presented Awards for academics and his contribution to Aviation. His academic accomplishments takes him up to the level of a Post Graduate Degree from the University of the West Indies, with a Master of Science in Aviation Management. He is presently pursuing a Doctorate in Business Administration at the same University.
